

**2010 Missouri Legislative Status Report**

**TOURISM**

**January 28, 2010**

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<b>HB 1272 (Bruns)</b>	Increases the rate that all counties and certain cities are authorized to impose, upon voter approval, or a transient guest tax on each occupied room, per night from up to 5% to up to 7%. <b>STATUS: Introduced</b>
<b>HB 1323 (Bringer)</b>	Requires the certificate of title for a new outboard motor to contain both the year the motor was manufactured and the year the dealer received the motor from the manufacturer. <b>STATUS: Introduced</b>
<b>HB 1367 (Schlottach)</b>	Allows any winery, distiller, manufacturer, wholesaler or brewer to provide beverage samples on certain licensed retail premises for tasting purposes. <b>STATUS: Introduced</b>
<b>HB 1378 (Salva)</b>	Modifies the definition of "restaurant bar" as it relates to the sale of liquor on Sundays. <b>STATUS: Introduced</b>
<b>HB 1388 (Day)</b>	Authorizes the City of Waynesville to impose, upon voter approval, a transient guest tax for a multipurpose conference and convention center. <b>STATUS: Introduced</b>
<b>HB 1412 (McGhee)</b>	Establishes in statute the Missouri State Park Board which is responsible for managing the Historical Marker Program. <b>STATUS: Introduced</b>
<b>HB 1557 (Kelly)</b>	Authorizes the City of Ashland to impose, upon voter approval, a transient guest tax for the promotion of tourism. <b>STATUS: Introduced</b>
<b>HB 1567 (Meiners)</b>	Allows the City of Grandview to impose a transient guest tax. <b>STATUS: Introduced</b>
<b>HB 1568 (Salva)</b>	Authorizes the City of Sugar Creek to impose, upon voter approval, a transient guest tax for the promotion of tourism. <b>STATUS: Introduced</b>
<b>HB 1587 (Grill)</b>	Increases the annual cap on the tax credits certified for qualified film production projects from \$4.5 million to \$10 million. <b>STATUS: Introduced</b>
<b>HB 1647 (Cooper)</b>	Changes the classification of certain watercraft from personal property to residential property for property taxation purposes. <b>STATUS: Introduced</b>
<b>HB 1724 (Sutherland)</b>	Authorizes Montgomery County transient guest tax. <b>STATUS: Introduced</b>
<b>SB 644 (Shields)</b>	Modifies provisions of law regarding certain taxes to fund tourism and convention centers. <b>STATUS: Senate Ways and Means Committee</b>
<b>SB 668 (Justus)</b>	Allows the City of Grandview to impose a transient guest tax. <b>STATUS: Senate Economic Development Committee; Hearing Held</b>
<b>SB 700 (Lager)</b>	Authorizes the creation of exhibition center and recreational facility districts in certain counties. <b>STATUS: Senate Economic Development Committee</b>

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**SB 703 (Vogel)**

**Modifies provisions relating to the imposition of transient guest taxes by certain local governments.**

**STATUS: Senate Commerce Committee**

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**SB 721 (Nodler)**

**Requires travel clubs to demonstrate that they have a least \$50,000 in liquid assets, rather than \$250,000.**

**STATUS: Senate General Laws Committee**

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**SB 745 (Bray)**

**Creates a statewide energy code for new building construction and renovation.**

**STATUS: Senate Commerce Committee**

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**SB 746 (Griesheimer)**

**Imposes various billboard standards to billboards adjacent to Interstate 70 and Interstate 44 during periods of interstate construction.**

**STATUS: Senate Transportation Committee**

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
